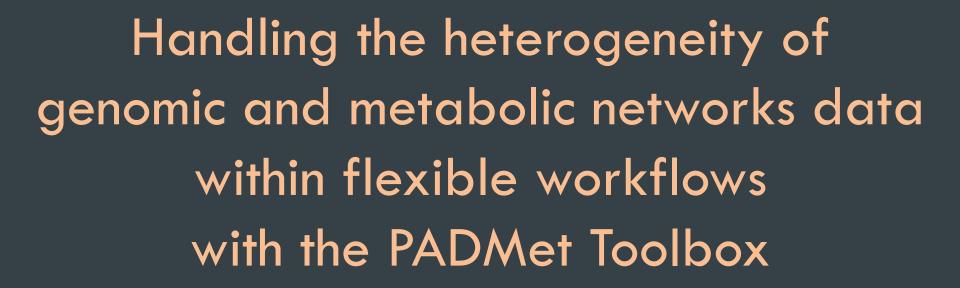

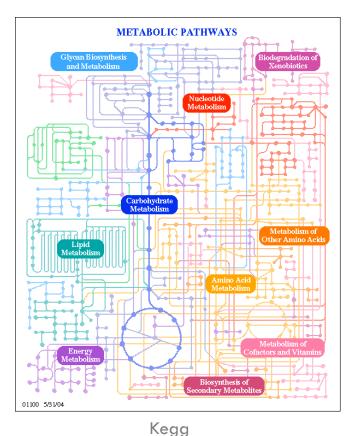
Context : high scale system biology

- □ Emergence of new technologies
 - Massive genome sequencing
 - High-throughput production of transcriptomic and metabolomic data
- Very high quantity of raw data
- How to manage these high scale data ?

Comprehend these omic data while reconstructing a metabolic network

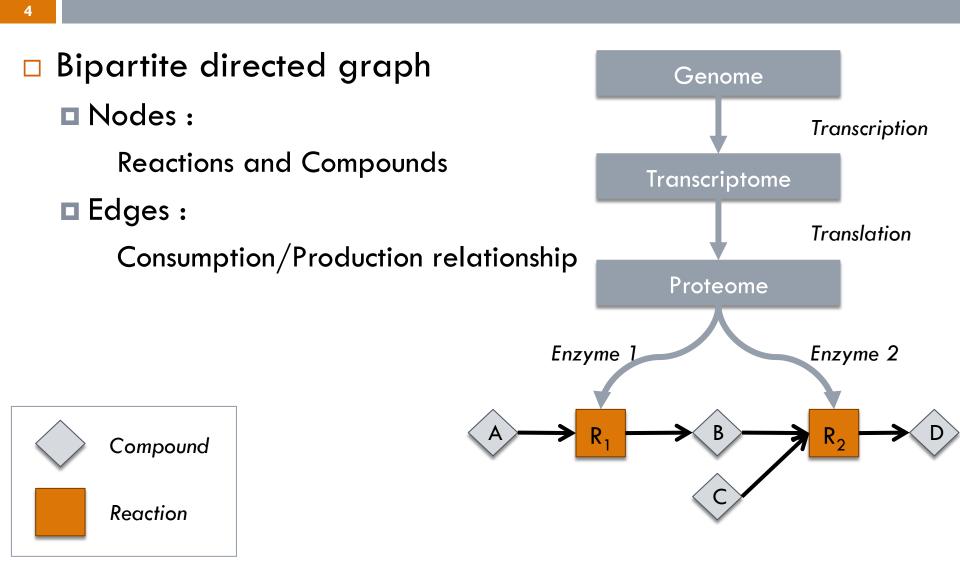
Genome scale metabolic network (MN)

- Describes all chemical and physical processes in a cell
 - Chemical reactions taking part into the cell metabolism
 - Transport reactions of compounds

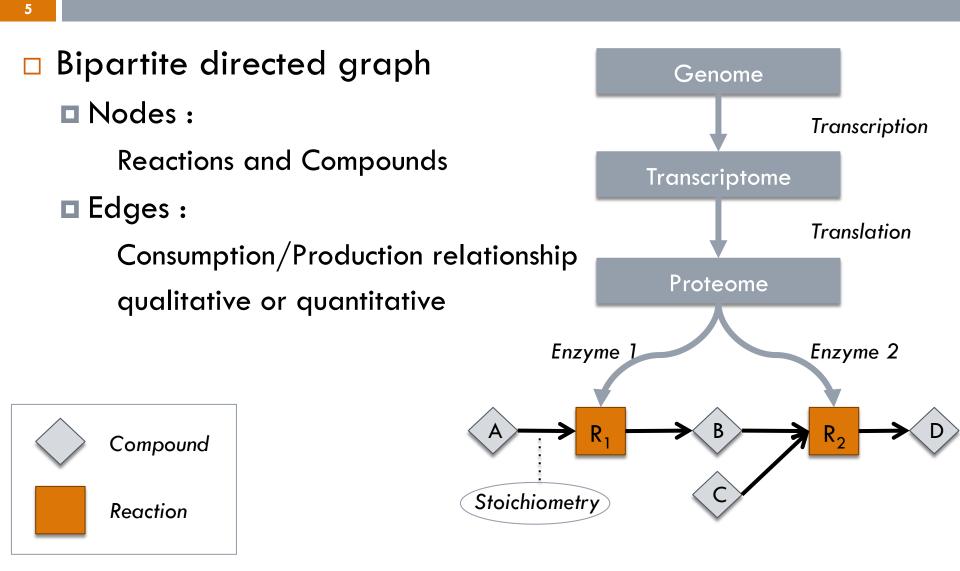

Metabolic network (MN) : modeling

- Bipartite directed graph
 - Nodes :
 - **Reactions and Compounds**
 - Edges :
 - Consumption/Production relationship
- SBML (Systems Biology Markup Language)
 Standard format (based on XML)
 Low flexibility (supplementary data)

Modeling standards : bipartite graph, SBML format

SBML format drawbacks

- Not suited for supplementary data

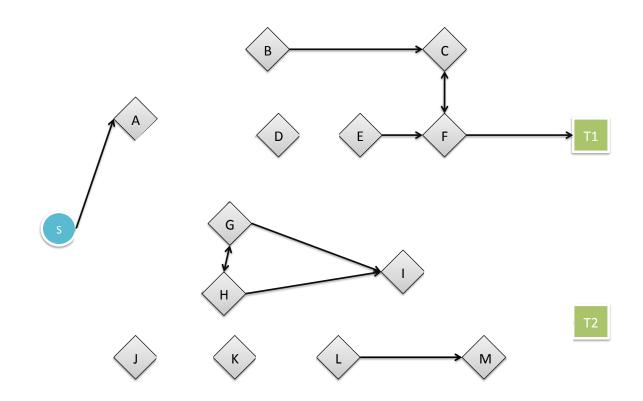

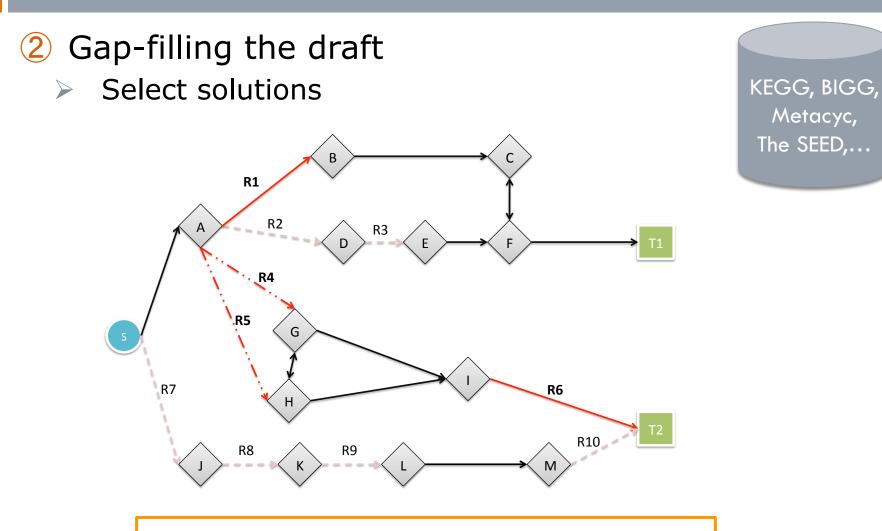

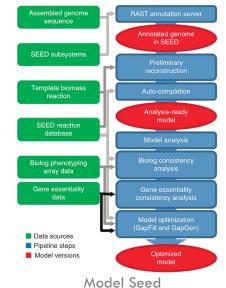
Workflows for MN reconstruction

11

- Involve a huge pool of tools
- Need specific steps of pre/postprocessing of data
- Use a lot of different input formats
- Require to carefully manage data until the output Standardization, Heterogeneity, Traceability
- Often linked to a specific data base

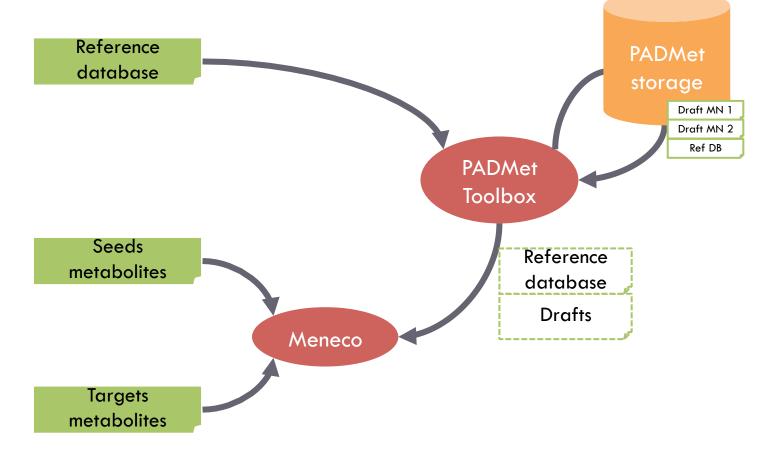

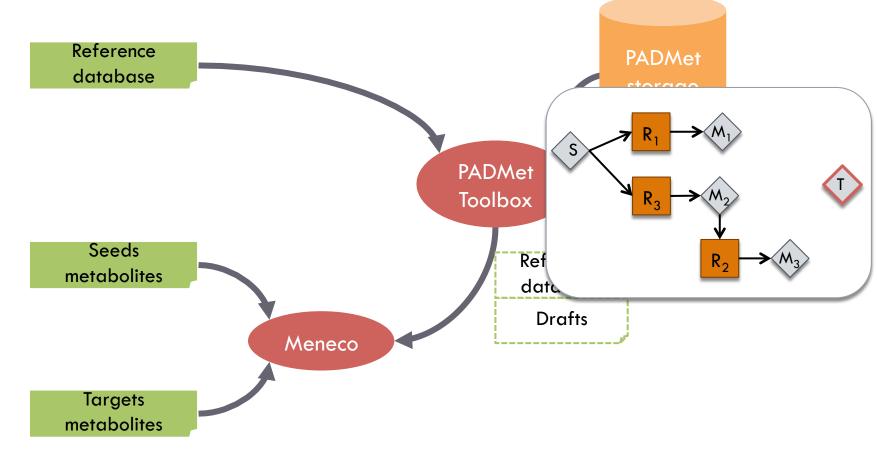

Reconstruction on Ectocarpus siliculosus (brown algae)



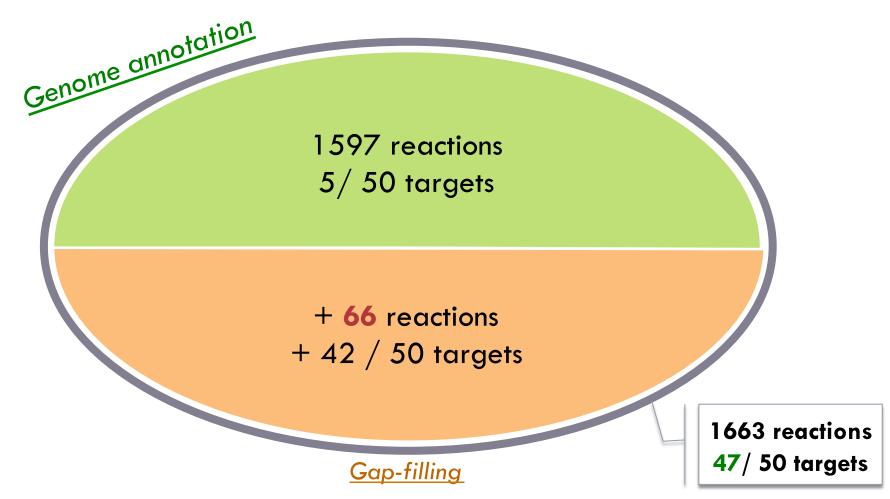

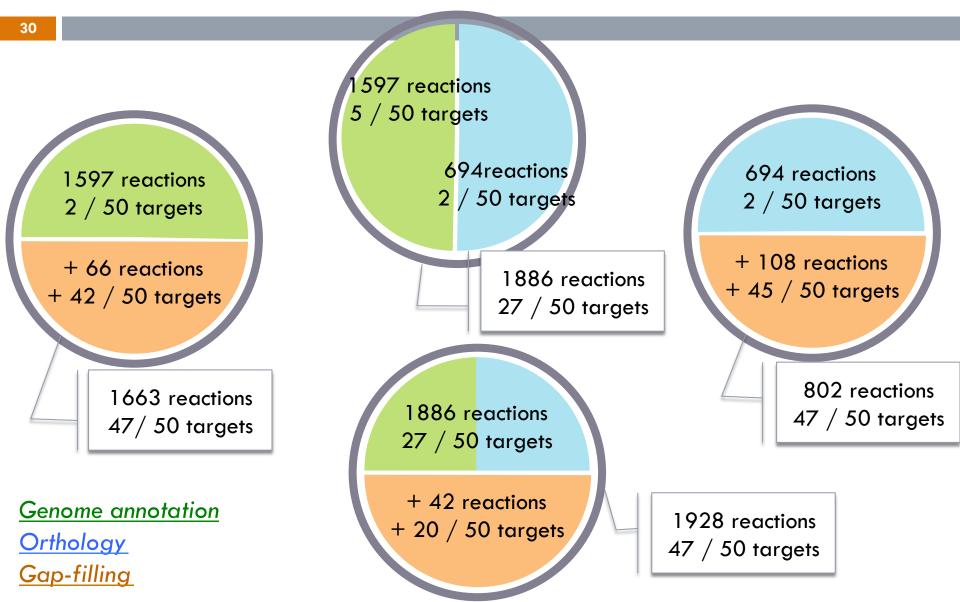

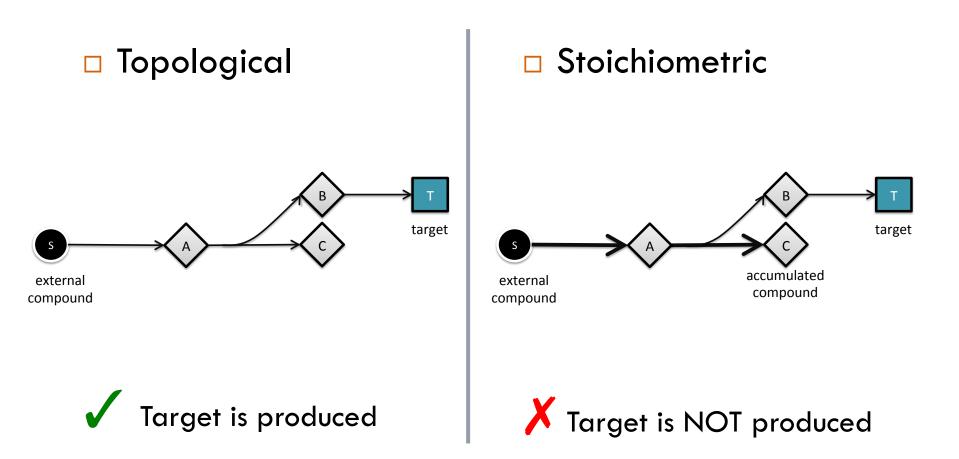
 $A + B \rightarrow C$
