Higher number of degrees of freedom comparing to the methods with continuous approximation

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### TREFFTZ METHOD

**DEFINITION** \*

Given a region of an Euclidean space of some partitions of that region,

a **Trefftz method** is any procedure for solving boundary value problems of PDE or systems of PDE, on such region,

using solutions of that PDE or its adjoint, defined in its subregions.
