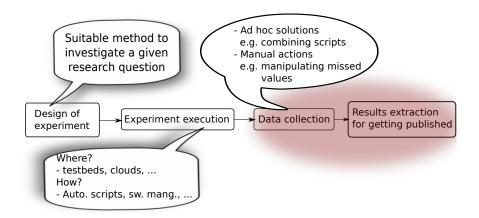


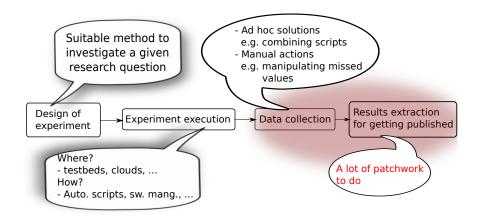
Abstracted life-cycle of a computer system experiment

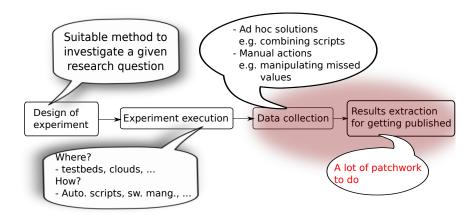












 Objective: enhancing data collection phase for better experiment portability and reproducibility

Context: monitoring

Infrastructure monitoring services?

- Work from point of view of infrastructure operators♦ Ideal for permanent detection of issues
- Do not scale for fine-grained measurements♦ Typical for taking measurements every 5 minutes
- Have not a definition of experiments
 e.g. Experiments' time boundaries are not specified

Experiment Monitoring Frameworks (EMFs)

Second Experiment: metrics diversity

- Metrics: HDD Util & power of a MongoDB cluster
- Three-shard nodes & 80 GB of total data
- Prometheus as a data collector & Grafana for visualization
- Two default node-exporters of Prometheus
 - \Rightarrow node-exporter \rightarrow nodes spec.
 - \Rightarrow SNMP-exporter \rightarrow PDUs data





Third Experiment: time-dependent & heavy-measurement

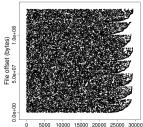
- Metric : file offsets vs sequences of I/O requests
- lacktriangle High-frequency measurement (thousands of I/O)
 - → pushing data to InfluxDB
- Generate I/O traces using IOscope [1]
- Fio benchmark generates rand. read workload
