PROS AND CONS



Adapted to the complex geometries High-order accuracy and hp-adaptivity Explicit semi-dicrete form Conservation laws



Higher number of degrees of freedom, compared to the methods with continuous approximation

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TREFFTZ METHOD

DEFINITION *

Given a region of an Euclidean space of some partitions of that region,

a Trefftz method is any procedure for solving BVP of PDE,

using solutions of that PDE or its adjoint, defined in its subregions.
